Did you know that Reading is a science?

Modern research calls for direct phonics instruction to build the foundation for strong reading skills. Because we believe in best practices, our Kindergarten, first, and second grade Title scholars are focused on Phonics this year! At ICPA, we are delivering evidence-based Phonics instruction so that students master letter sounds and build fluency. "If a child memorises 10 words, the child can only read 10 words. But if a child learns 10 sounds, the child will be able to read 350 three sound words, 4 320 four sound words and 21 650 five sound words."
